LASCNA Treasurer's Report
May 1, 2016

Greetings Louisville Area Service Committee NA Members,

I have the April Bank Statement, Reconciliation Report, Check Register, Home Group Donation Report and all the other information with me today. As of May 1, 2016, we have a current Balance of **\$17,550.23** in our account. When we take away our \$5000 prudent reserve we have \$12,550.23 left in expendable income for which to conduct business. All of our other normal bills for the month of April have been paid. In April we wrote checks for \$4,816.73 and deposited \$2,927.59. **We wrote checks for \$1,889.14 more money than deposited into our account in the month of April.** We also had 2 checks by 2 Home Groups for their literature orders, one for \$24.13 and another for \$33.29 for a total of \$57.42 that were returned for insufficient funds (NFS/UNC). Therefore \$57.42 was withdrawn from our account and there may be an additional service charge for depositing these checks. These two checks were then were a Re-deposit of Returned Items and the \$57.42 was deposited back into our account. If there is a service fee for this process it should be reflected on next month's Bank Statement and these Home Groups will be expected to reimburse Aree for these fees and are to use money orders in the future according to our P&P Page 13, Item #10.

All the transactions are listed at the end of this report.


LASCNA April 2016 Home Group 7th Tradition Donations


Breakdown of Louisville Area Home Group Donations for April


- 65 home groups in the Louisville Area in April 2016
- 26 groups donated to Area (40 % of all home groups)
- 39 groups did not donate anything to Area (60% of all home groups)
- 16 groups donated \$20 or less (25% of all home groups)
- 4 groups donated \$21 to \$40 (6% of all home groups)
- 4 groups donated \$41 to \$80 (6% of all home groups)
- 1 groups donated \$81 to \$99 (1.5% of all home groups)
- 1 group donated \$100 to \$110.46 (1.5% of all home groups)
- 0 individual donated to the Area this month
- OVANA did not donate to Area this month

On page 13 in the LASCNA Policy and Procedures Manual, under the section Area Treasurer Responsibilities, it states in #12 that it the Responsibility of the Area Treasurer to “encourage the GSR to remind their groups of the importance of the Seventh Tradition at every level of service, beginning with the member and then the group and will briefly explain what this money provides.
