Dear Louisville area,

First and foremost I must acknowledge the God of my understanding for the privilege of allowing me to serve. I personally want to thank Crystole Rand the H&I sub-committee for seeing enough in me, through my service in H&I to nominate me, and thanks to all other home groups and members for your trust and faith. I believe that "no addict seeking recovery need die without a chance to find a better way of life".

We spent \$ 164.39 on literature for the month of January 2019.

We are currently taking in 11/16 meetings into facilities who do not have full access to regular NA meetings. Anna B has been shadowing me and Karen at CARC for the last month and will be taking a meeting into CARC starting this month, for 3/4 at that facility.

I'm submitting the annual budget for H&I 2019. Our current budget is \$ **4248.00**, as stated on page 30 of our P and P. The budget will remain the same as 2018 even though I've added a meeting to our list (Landmark Recovery). Several meetings are still not filled and our current monthly allotment allows for 15 meetings. In the event that all 16 meetings become filled and an increase is needed, then I will submit a request to increase our budget. (For 2019 budget details see attached)

The H&I Subcommittee exist to carry the Narcotics Anonymous message of recovery from addiction to residents of facilities who do not have full access to regular NA meetings.
