March 2019 Vice Chair Report

Our bank balance for March 01 is \$7688.56. Last month we took in \$774.74 in 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition Home group donations and took in \$1351.41 in literature sales. We wrote checks totaling \$2205.06. As of February 1<sup>st</sup> 2019, we had a beginning balance of \$9841.49. After deducting the amount of checks written (2205.06) and adding the money taken in last month (2126.15) we have a current balance of \$7688.56. When we deduct our \$6520.00 prudent reserve we have \$1168.56 to conduct business in March.
