Rule 370 Notification Requirements

If you have opened a deposit Account on behalf of the beneficial owner(s) of the funds in the Account (for example as an agent, nominee, guardian, executor, custodian, or funds held in some other capacity for the benefit of others), those beneficial owners may be eligible for "pass-through" insurance from the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) (each, a "Pass-Through Account").
