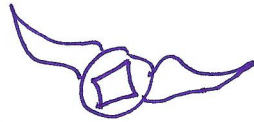

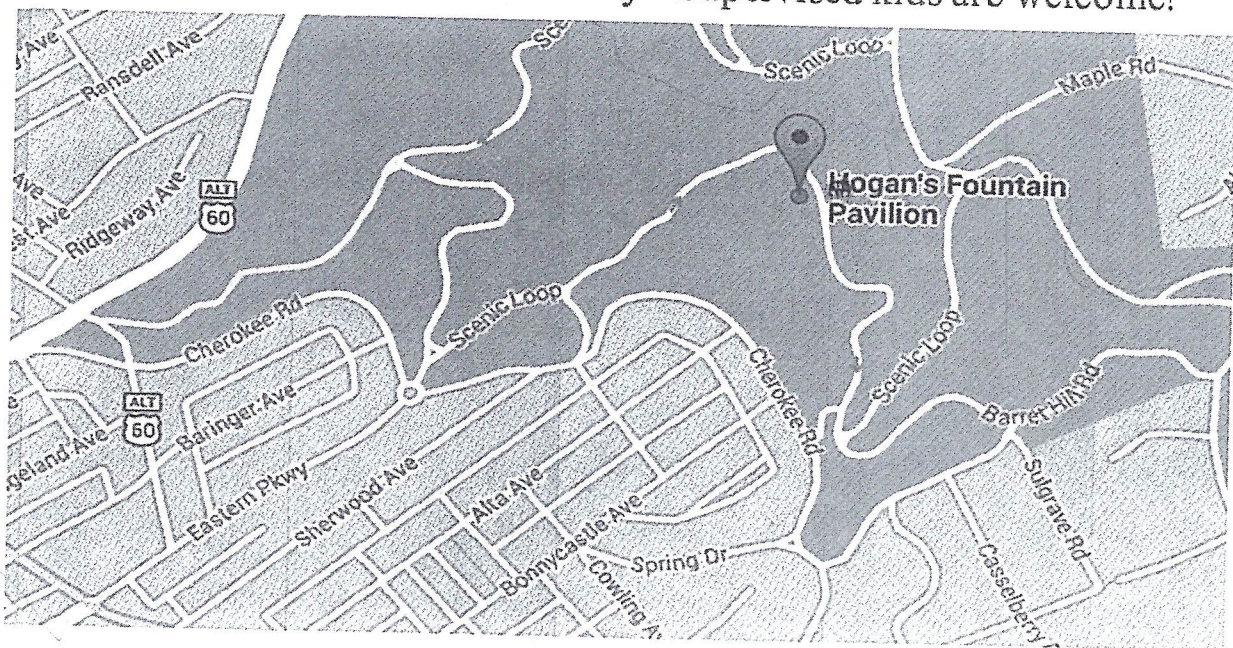

Dear Louisville Area Homegroups and members,

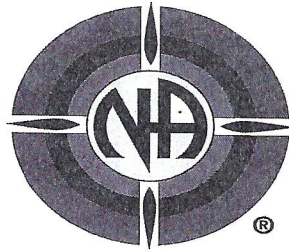
“As long as the ties that bind us together are stronger than those that would tear us apart, all will be well.” Just as our addiction and recovery has bonded us to the fellowship, so has the group conscience of the Louisville area bonded LASCNA, the sub-committee of Hospitals and Institutions, and the requirement of service to carry our message of HOPI to the still suffering addict in facilities who cannot get out to regular NA meetings.

Tradition One: Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends on NA unity.”

“We had convinced ourselves that we could make it alone and proceeded to live life on that basis.” (Potential Addict) “The results were disastrous and, in the end, each of us had to admit that self-sufficiency was a lie.” (Recovering Addict) (BT)..... “This admission was the starting point of our recovery and is a primary point of unity for the Fellowship.” (BT)

H & I is currently taking in 12 meetings out of 15 per week. We have been Ok'd to bring in 4 more meetings at Centerstone. There are 2 meetings waiting to be filled at Dismas and I have been notified about 3 more potential meetings that we can add to the list once we have enough Panel Leaders to fill the positions. We have a need for recovering addicts who are willing to commit to service work on the area level. One month of recovery is the minimum requirement to shadow Panel Leaders and six months to become a Panel Member of H & I. Panel Leaders must have at least one year clean. You can get with a Panel Leader or come to our Sub-committee meeting.

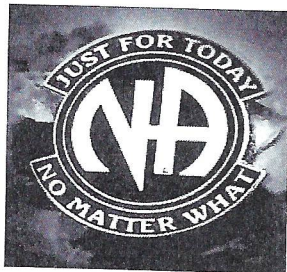

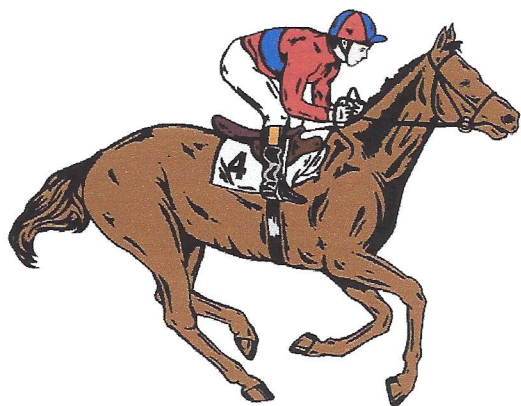
