Good afternoon family,

There is a lot to go over so bear with me and buckle up. The regional bank account has \$30,758.05 in it. That is a lot of money but fortunately we have a great treasurer in Mark S. The Annual Budget in the P&P is \$19,415.00 and that is also included in the Regional P&P I attached in this report. The other Areas in our Region are doing well aside from some of them having open positions like the Louisville area has but all in all the meetings are going well and the fund raisers for KRCNA 39 have been a success. At Region we are working on getting a fund raiser schedule made so we don't have to worry about conflicting functions happening. The Louisville area always has ours in late March or early April but due to that KRCNA 39 being April 3rd - 5th, if we are going to have one it would have to be in March. I have attached the most recent flyer for KRCNA 39 with all the info on it in this report.

The first big business item is this year's WSC CAR. [World Service Conference - Narcotics Anonymous World Services](#) is the link and the website that can be gone to if you want to take a deep dive into it. I have also attached the PDF with the CAR's info on this report. Here is a summary:

The Narcotics Anonymous (NA) **2026 Conference Agenda Report (CAR)** includes key motions for discussion and voting at the World Service Conference (WSC) in May 2026 on the 3rd-9th. If you would like to attend it there will be a virtual way to attend. The main motions involve approving new literature, adopting a new strategic plan, changing the frequency of the World Convention, and exploring the use of technology like AI and tablets for incarcerated members.

Key Motions in the 2026 CAR

The CAR compiles motions from NA regions and the World Board for the WSC. World Services Committee

- **Literature Approval:** Motion 1 proposes replacing the current version of **IP #21, *Staying Clean in Isolation***, with a revised edition.
- **Strategic Plan:** Motion 2 aims to adopt the **2026–2029 NA World Services Strategic Plan**.
- **World Convention Frequency:** Motion 3 suggests holding the World Convention (WCNA) every **five years** starting in 2028, with the World Board selecting the location.
- **Technology for Incarcerated Members:** Motion 4 directs research into providing book-length literature on tablets to incarcerated addicts, in addition to current PDF and audio options.
- **AI Interpretation:** Motion 5 proposes using AI for WSC meeting interpretation instead of human interpreters.

Issue Discussion Topics (IDTs)

The CAR also lists topics for fellowship-wide discussion and input via surveys. These include:

- Member involvement in service
- Decision-making and delegation
- Handling disruptive behavior
- Fellowship unity
- Using technology to help addicts find meetings
- Management of funds
- Social media use
- Engaging long-time members

How to Learn More or Provide Input

The complete 2026 CAR and related materials are available on the NA website at na.org/conference. Members are encouraged to review these documents, discuss the motions, and provide input through the online survey at na.org/surveys by **April 1, 2026**.

These surveys can be found at [NAWS Projects and Surveys - Narcotics Anonymous World Services](#). NAWS surveys are opportunities for members to share their views and help shape the projects planned for future conference cycles.

I am going to be working with our Regional Delegate and the Regional Delegate Alternate to find out when they are going to have their workshop. Rodney did inform me that they try to have it at KRCNA since a lot of the areas will be there. He said he will let me know more when he finds out, and once the dates are ironed out. If they are not, then I will schedule a workshop for anyone who would like to attend and learn more. I will announce the date and location of the Regional workshop at the next area meeting if I get information that Region is not holding a workshop.

The second big item of business I need to bring up is that Louisville is scheduled to host KRCNA 40. This will be in April 2027. We need to decide if we want to host the event. Ever since Covid,

region has been out of sorts on the rotation, but we now have a stable rotation. I have attached the regional rotation moving forward. Technically, we should have had the nomination for the KRCNA chair this past May, but we haven't been able to conduct Regional business for the last 4 months, and I was informed we are next on the rotation in November. I have included Regions P&P for reference. Page 5 and 9 is where the pertinent information is located. At the bottom of this report, I will attach the requirements for the KRCNA chair position for reference. We still have some time to get moving, but we need nominations by January's area meeting so the nominations can be voted on by the Home groups and we can elect the chair at February's area meeting. At that point the nominee will have to be at the March's Regional meeting to read their resume and get voted in. Once we vote them in at our area in February, they could start shadowing this year's committees if they like. When they go to region to get elected, it is just a formality. We elect who we want to chair the event.

KENTUCKIANA REGION CONVENTION of NA (KRCNA) CHAIRPERSON REQUIREMENTS:

1. Clean time requirement is three years in Narcotics Anonymous.
2. This is an eighteen-month commitment.
3. Must provide the time and resources necessary to be an active participant.
4. Must have completed a service involvement with a previous Narcotics Anonymous convention.
5. Regular attendance at all RSC meetings is required.
6. Prepares a written report for each KRSCNA meeting and makes all motions on behalf of and is the voice of the Convention subcommittee.
7. Ensures that the funds, books, receipts, and archives are turned over to the KRSCNA within ninety days after the Convention and presented to the next convention chairperson.
8. Must collect all Convention subcommittee chairpersons' detailed report of their committee functions and budget requirements to be turned in at the KRSCNA meeting following the convention. This time limit is not to exceed the ninety-day time limit set forth in their requirements and duties.
9. Demonstrated stability in the local community and administrative abilities.
10. Organize subcommittees and delegate major tasks to specific subcommittee.
11. Stays informed of the activities of each subcommittee and provide help when needed.
12. Helps resolve personality conflicts.
13. Keep activities within the principles of the Twelve Traditions of Narcotics Anonymous and in accord with the purpose of the convention.
14. Monitors the fund flow and overall convention costs and helps organize the subcommittee's budgets.
15. Prepares a budget for the Executive committee's functions.
16. Prevents important questions from being decided prematurely in order to foster understanding by the entire committee prior to action.
17. Allows the subcommittees to do their jobs while providing guidance and support. Subcommittees should be given trust and encouragement to use their own judgment.
18. Prepares agenda for the Convention committee meetings and the Executive committee meetings.
19. Votes only to break a tie.
20. Chair the convention as well as the Convention committee meetings.
21. Acts as liaison between the KRSC and the Convention Committee.

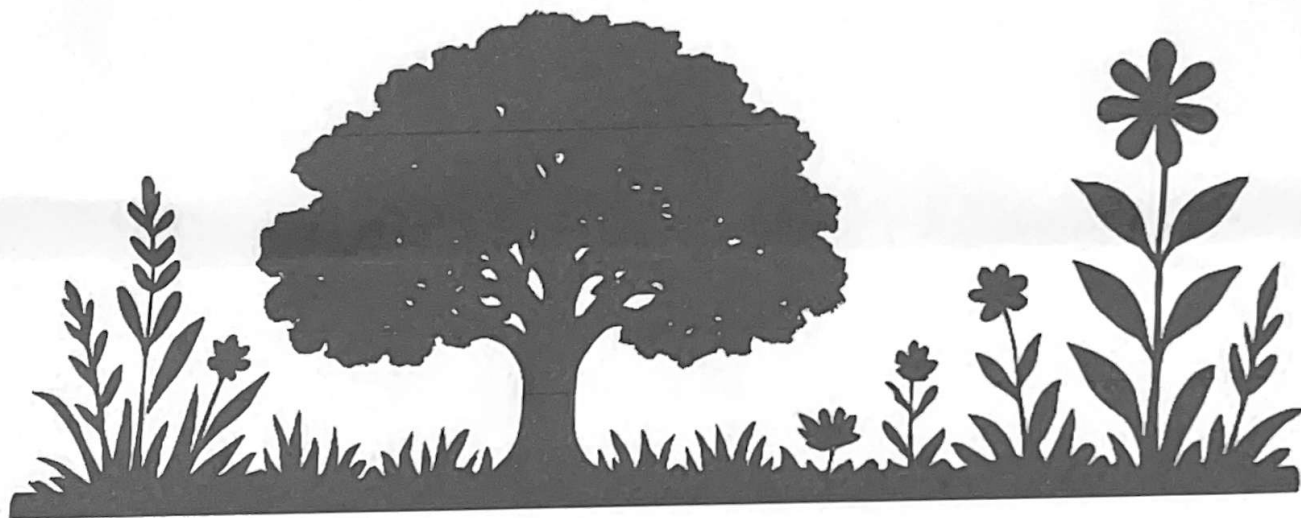
