Good day Family,

All in all the other areas in our Region are doing well. Home Groups are healthy and addicts are getting helped. Some of the areas are having a hard time getting service positions filled but aside from that they are good. The Region has \$30,758.05 cents in the bank. I have attached the Regional P&P for reference on how that money is spent and what it is needed for. Last years KRCNA's final financial report was finalized with a profit of \$9,357.09 cents. \$6000 of that was the seed money so once that was subtracted, the final profit was \$3,357.03 cents. Per the Regional P&P, 40% goes to WSO which was \$1,342.83 cents. That leaves a final profit for the Region at \$2,014.26 cents.

The RD was not present at the last 2 Regional meetings, so a letter of concern was sent to him. More to come with that. The RDA did have a report which stated that due to the P&P this year's CAR will be represented by KBRNA's RD and our Regions RDA. Rodney plans on going to this conference. He told me that KBRNA's RD plans on doing an in-person CAR workshop in March and if they do not then he is going to do a hybrid workshop in March. That gives Home Groups the chance to go to them and get more information before votes need to be sent in. Any votes or surveys need to be turned in by April 1st.

502 was officially taken off the roll call which let us move on with some Regional business that was getting held up by us not knowing if they still wanted to be part of the Regions rotation. I have attached the motions for consideration of a **floor vote**. Motion 6-1-25 proposes that if an Area passes on KRCNA that it goes to the next Area in the Rotation for consideration on putting that years KRCNA on. The reason that motion has not been voted on yet is due to the Region not being able to meet quorum. I promise I was at the first meeting that didn't meet quorum and the second meeting was called off due to Areas not being able to make it to the camp out. I was willing to go to that meeting but was told we would not be having the meeting the night before it was scheduled to be had. If that motion passes, then motion 11-1-25 is the proposed Regional event rotation. This motion is to simplify and set which Area is doing what when. This rotation has already been in effect for years, but this motion will get it officially in the P&P without 502. The simplification is so if an Area does pass on KRCNA all activities such will pass to the next group of Areas to lessen confusion of who did what activity and when. 11-2-25 has to do with getting the KRCNA fundraiser schedule in the P&P so we know what Area is putting their fundraiser on and when. This schedule has already been in effect for years but at least gets it in the P&P. This also will ensure Areas are not putting on KRCNA fundraisers at the same time which would affect the capacity each Area can bring in by competing fundraisers. Attached in my report are the official motions for reference.

Last but not least, Eric M., who was the RCM for ATRANA was floor voted in as Regions Vice Chair. The position was vacant for so long without anybody showing interested in doing the position, and per the Regional P&P, if a RCM showed interest and a position needed filled so they could start shadowing the current Chair, a floor vote could be made to vote them in. Everyone at Region knew him well, and he has done a ton of service for our Region.

The next Regional meeting will be held in the Owensboro Area on 1/18 at 1 P.M. C.S.T. It will be held at the Unity Fellowship Church on 625 Allen Street, Owensboro Ky., 42303. In Loving Service.

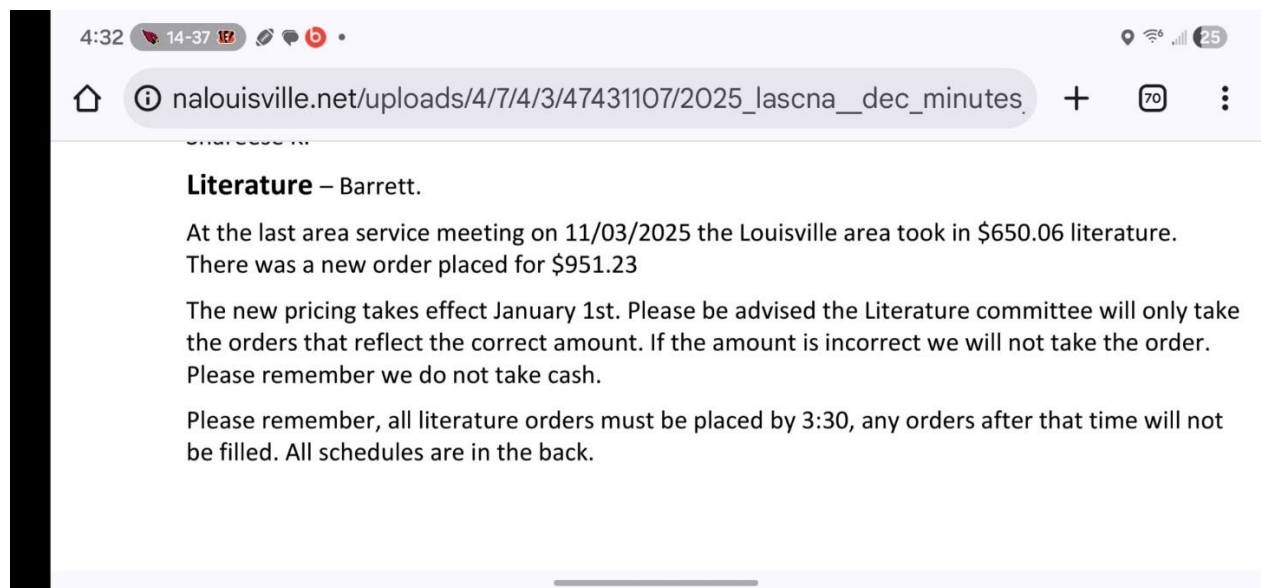

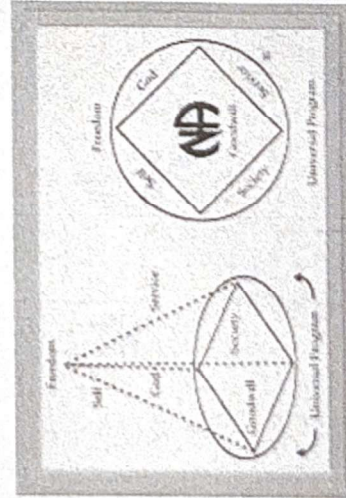
