Good Afternoon Family,

Our last Regional meeting was held here in Louisville on 5/17/26. We had a great in person turnout with around 10 people showing up. The Metro Spanish Area was also in attendance to drum up some support for their convention on July 23rd-the 26th. I brought a flyer just in case our Area doesn't have one yet. They are having 22 Spanish speakers and 11 English speakers at the event. Reach out to Javier P. at (917) 600-2309 if you or someone you know wants to be a speaker.

All in all the other Areas are doing fine. Some Areas are struggling with attendance and getting addicts into service but more than not they are doing OK. The Region's current bank account balance is \$29,162.92 cents. The Pennyryle Area is next up to do KRCNA41 so we are awaiting to see if they want to hold the event or pass. More will be revealed. The Metro Spanish Area requested some literature from our Region for their Convention and the Region still had a \$400.00 literature budget that had not been touched this year. The RCM's from the Areas did pros and cons and felt like donating Basic Texts to the Convention was a great way to further the message and help addicts. Since the literature funds were in the budget it did not need to go back to the Areas to be voted on. We did a floor vote and approved the funds to help the Metro Spanish Convention. Personally I felt like it was good that the Region was spending the money they are sitting on to further our primary purpose.

The CAR & CAT info is available at **NA.ORG**. In a nutshell, all the motions passed except Motion 5 which had to do with implementing A.I. interpretation solutions for the World Service Committee meeting. Again, there is a ton of info online for you to dig into if you are so inclined.
