LASCNA Public Relations Subcommittee – Monthly Report

Good afternoon everyone,

We have begun forming a new PR subcommittee and may possibly begin to meet on the same day ASC meets monthly. It's a work in progress and more will be revealed.

We hope to send the schedule to the printer this week. Please let us know of any changes, corrections, etc. needed.

I've had a month to seek out the people who have been doing all the PR work behind the scenes dealing with the four different web sites - API, or Application Programming Interfaces that handle nalouisville.net & ovana.org. The Basic Meeting List Toolbox (**BMLT**) is the core application

Using this technology, our areas have made huge strides forward in providing accurate up to date information for anyone visiting our web sites or calling the Helpline.

Our Helpline is connected to the website schedule so when anything is added or altered on the website, it instantly translates to the meetings listed on the Helpline.

Once the Helpline call responders used pagers. If the responders page was not answered in 5 minutes, the call would route to the next pager and repeat down the line. Later, the responders cell phone would show a call had come in to the Helpline and if that cell did not respond in 5 minutes, it was routed to the next cell.

Now, all 11 responders receive the call at the same time. Missed calls are for all practical purposes at zero. The only *problem* is the call responders have to be a "Quick Draw" or somebody else gets it before they do.

We are working toward integrating our printed schedule into the toolkit so when the website schedule to changed, it immediately adjusts the schedule template we send to the printer.

Also, we are exploring having local TV stations run Public Service Announcements, Ads placed on TARC busses, and Billboards.

Lastly, we will be trying to contact Home Groups who have not stayed in contact with ASC. Per LASCNA P&P pg 17:

21. In order to remain on the Louisville Area printed schedule, website meeting schedule, or helpline schedule, all home groups must have a representative stay in contact

with the subcommittee. This can be done by attending ASC at least every two months or by calling or emailing the PR Subcommittee at least every two months.

If anyone speaks with members of the following groups, please ask them to keep us updated. Lets all work together to make sure our schedules are accurate.
