Good day family,

I apologize I was not able to be part of last month's Area meeting, but the good thing is we were actually able to conduct business at the Regional meeting that occurred while our area meeting was being held. All areas attended except 502. 502 has missed every regional meeting this year and a letter of concern was sent in May but unfortunately, we have not gotten a response. Due to 502 holding up regional motions and non-participation we cited the Regional P&P which states that they could be removed from the region if certain criteria were met and that criteria was indeed met. From this point on 502 is not part of the Kentuckiana region. One caveat that I will say is the Regional Delegate for our region is going to be filing a motion stating that we didn't follow the regional P&P in regard to where and when the Regional meeting was held. Worst case is that we have to vote on the Regional rotation and 502's removal again but the outcomes will most likely be the same unless 502 actually shows up to the Regional meeting.

The Regions bank balance was \$29,882.01 All the other Areas are doing well.

KRCNA 39 is alive and thriving! They were excited to share that they decided on a preconvention logo and secured the hotel. You can now find the booking link for the rooms at the DoubleTree in Evansville on their website. A new registration flier will be available soon. They are also preparing pre-convention merchandise and moving forward in a positive way. One thing they need from each area in our region is an approximate date for their KRCNA fundraisers. To kick things off, ATRANA will host the first KRCNA 39 fundraiser on November 2nd at Scales Lake Shelter House in Boonville, IN. The SCKA KRCNA fundraiser is December at Hillview Heights but a flyer is not yet available for more information such as address and time. I have attached a few flyers with other areas' events. I will be reaching out to the Activities committee before our next Regional meeting so I can get information on if we are holding our fundraiser on April like years past. KRCNA 39 are still accepting workshop speaker submissions. If you're interested or know someone who is, please send them their way. A flyer is attached with the info to get a hold pf them.

Our last function, which was October 18, had an end total of **\$711.29**. Function & Fundraiser used **\$235.42**, resulting in a **profit of \$485**. We also have another **deposit of \$500** to pay the hotel before the convention.

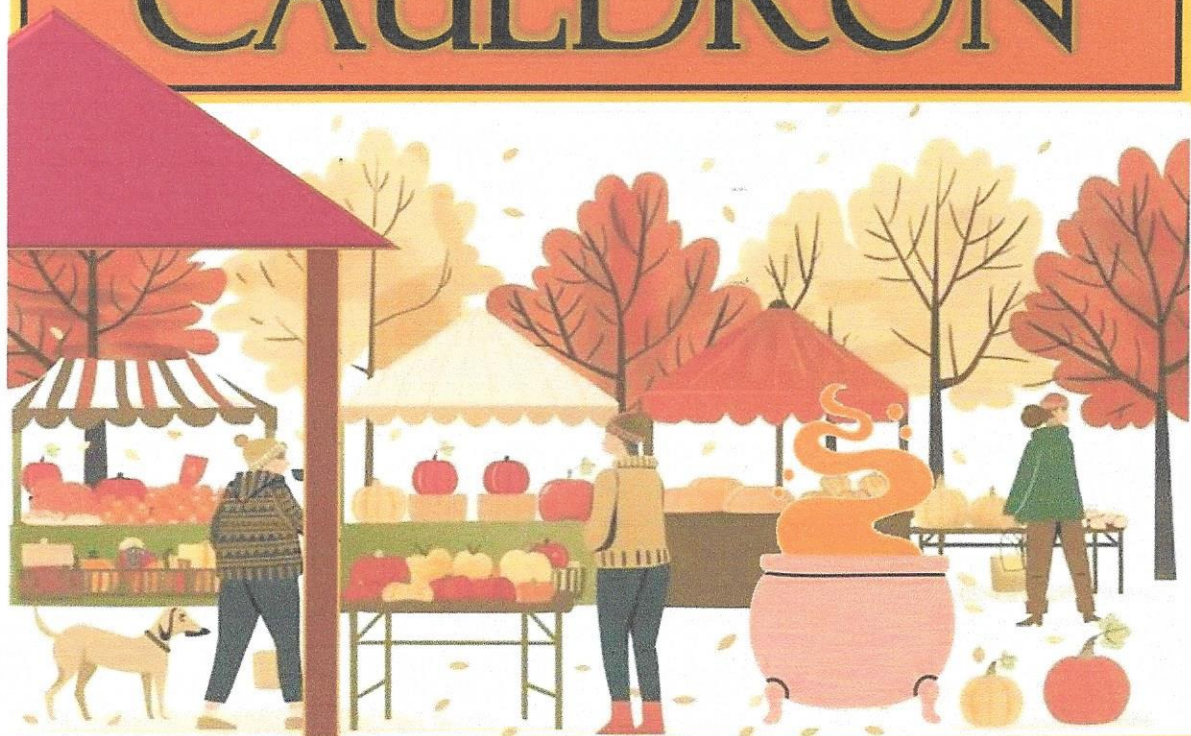

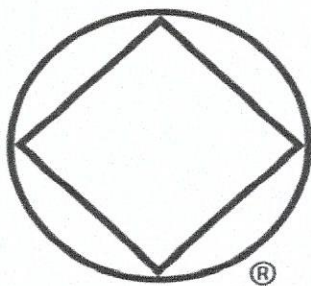
