LACNA 34 –Bobby E.- Report given and turned in.

Good afternoon, Louisville Area:

I am here today because I understand that there are groups that have questions about the finances of LACNA 34. I will give a brief synopsis of our finances, and then I will answer any questions to the best of my knowledge.

The final Balance for LACNA 34 was \$10,984.35, of which \$25.00 was left in the bank to keep the account open for LACNA 35.

The host hotel was paid a \$1,500.00 deposit, a first installment of \$5,737.21, and a final payment of \$5,119.99 equaling \$12,357.20.

The area provided LACNA 34 with the initial seed money of \$4,000.00, with a request of an additional \$5,000.00 of which \$3,165.06 was used. The actual outlay for the Area was \$7,165.06. Subtracting that amount from the ending balance, LACNA 34 generated \$3,819.28.

I know that this amount is not what we are used to LACNA generating, but there are extenuating circumstances, such as we do not usually pay for the meeting rooms and event spaces which we did this year reflecting in the payments to the host hotel.

We are providing most home groups with a copy of the overall spreadsheet with the hope that that will assist you in answering any questions you may have. I am also submitting the same spreadsheet to the secretary to include in the minutes. This will be my last report and the business of LACNA 34 is complete.

Owensboro took in around \$1600 and Bowling Green took in around \$2600 at their fundraisers. The convention is at the Owensboro Convention Center, 501 W. 2ndSt. On April 18th through the 20th.

Motion 9124 for the \$5000 going to WSO did pass 3 Yes, 1 No, and 1 abstained. Motion 9224 for the \$500 to OVANA for their H&I also passed with 4 Yes, 0 No, and 1 Abstained.

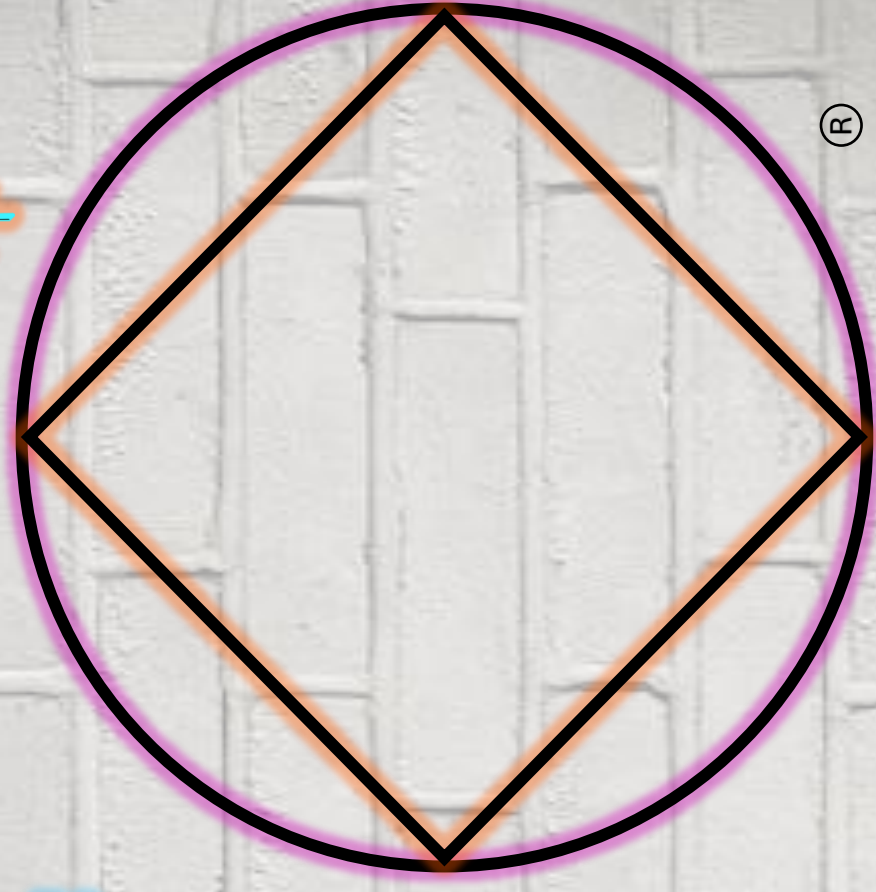

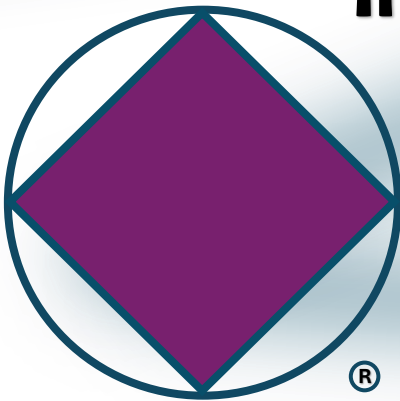
