RD Report:

The final inputs have been submitted for the revisions of IP 21 The Loner- Staying Clean and Isolation and the first section of the H&I Basics "Corrections". The H&I Basics is being revised in three sections, Corrections, Treatment, and Committees. The next section should be ready for input soon.

The Washington DC, World Convention of Narcotics Anonymous 38 Financial report has been released. The Expense over income was \$995,897. This may look like a huge loss, but the Message of Narcotics Anonymous was delivered to thousands of addicts and that is priceless. However, as a result, The World Board has decided to not have a World Convention in 2027. The future of the World Convention will be reviewed by the Board and more will be revealed.

The Southern Zonal Forum will be meeting Oct 24-26 at the Premier Best Western, in Louisville KY. Rm rate is \$120. I have reached out to the Louisville Area Activities Committee, and they will be hosting their Halloween Event at this function. Flyers will be available soon.

The KRCNA reports are,

(38) Occurred on April 18-20th at the Owensboro Convention Center. Many commented that the speakers were outstanding. We had approximately 149 preregistrations, 125 registered the day of the convention for a total of 274 participants. We have \$11,335.73 in the bank with one outstanding check to reconcile to the hotel for \$1573.26. There are a couple of miscellaneous expenses to clear up. We will be writing two checks to region, one for the \$6,000 return of the seed money and another for the rest when all is reconciled.

(39) On April 20th, we launched early bird registration both online and in person at KRCNA 38. We're happy to report that 99 early bird registrations were sold on that day! Since then, pre-convention registration has been available online for \$25 at <https://kentuckianana.org/krcna-39/>. We've been touring venues for KRCNA 39. So far, we've looked at Doubletree, Bally's, and Old National Events Plaza. The committee plans to make a final decision on the location in June. For any questions related to Hotels & Hospitality, please contact Matt K.

The Theme and Logo Contest is currently underway and open for submissions until July 1, 2025. The winner(s) will receive a free registration to KRCNA 39. (Theme and logo can be won separately.) 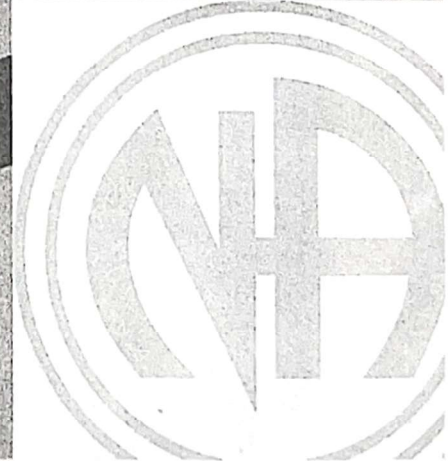
