I emailed the meeting minutes to Chase Bank to be added to the signature card, The bank rep stated they would review and reach out on next steps but have not hear back. Emailed asking for an update after one week with no response.

The minutes were completed and distributed 1 day late this month; printed, and mailed on 4/21/25. I spent approximately 3 hours completing the minutes for anyone considering the secretary position.

Under the new quorum policy, quorum for May area business meeting will be set at 16 (based on 29 homegroups with voting status, calculated as $50\% + 1 = 15$). Establishing quorum before the business meeting will enhance efficiency and slightly reduce meeting duration.

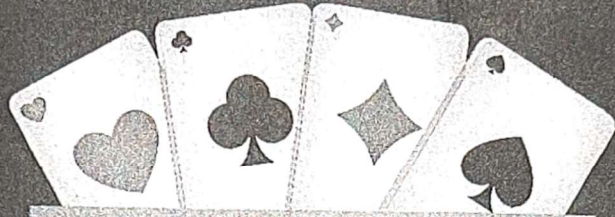
